

Notes from the Nurse:

Dear Parents,

We have made it through the first month of school! I just have some reminders and requests to make of you, the parent.

Health

1. A temperature over 100.4 is considered a fever. They cannot attend school with this temperature, even if treated with Tylenol or Motrin. They must be totally fever free for 24 hours before returning to school.
2. Please consider getting your student a FLU vaccination. School is one of the places your child will have a good chance of getting exposed.

Attendance

1. Tardiness: We pray together as a school community at **8:00 AM**. Classroom doors are closed at this time. Students are considered **tardy after the 8:00AM bell**. Please make every effort to bring your child to school on time. • Students arriving after 8:00 AM must report directly to homeroom. • Parents are required to sign their child in and submit a late slip. • Arriving late for school is a permanent part of a student's record. Excessive Unexcused Tardy Policy: It is very important that your child/children arrive at Seton Catholic School on time every day. Our goal is to provide the best education possible for your child and having them prepared to start the day on time each day is a very important step. While unforeseen events can sometimes happen, students who are habitually late are disruptive to the class and to their own academic success and can easily fall behind in their school work. Therefore, we have the following policy in place:
2. • If a student has **more than 4 unexcused tardies in a month**, the student will be given **lunch/recess detention for one day**. • After 3 lunch/recess detentions for tardiness are given, the student will then be referred to the Principal for further discipline.

Other The Counter Permission Slips

The Nurse is not allowed to use any lotions, ointments, Vaseline, acetaminophen, ibuprofen, or cough drops if a permission slip doesn't have MD signature.
