Financial Aid

The need for financial aid is determined through a process administered by FACTS Grant & Aid. The application can be found at <https://online.factsmgmt.com/signin/3G3Y0>. All applications for financial aid must be submitted no later than May 15, 2023. There is a \$35.00 fee for applying that is charged by FACTS.

Once all applicants have been submitted, the Seton Committee on Financial Aid will assemble and allocate the financial aid dollars available to our Seton families. The financial aid award will be credited to the families' FACTS Tuition account in July 2023.

Family Ambassador Program

The Family Ambassador Program encourages families to provide referrals to any one of the 16 Diocese of Rochester Catholic Schools. It is an opportunity for more of our community to discover the difference of a transformative, faith-based education.

Both the referral family and newly enrolled family will receive up to a \$500 tuition credit when the brand-new family joins any of the 16 Diocese of Rochester Catholic Schools. The credit will be distributed at the end of the 2023-2024 academic year. <https://www.dorschools.org/ambassador>

Building a Brighter Future Scholarship

The Building A Brighter Future Scholarship is a scholarship available to new students, K-8th grade, across our Diocesan schools. The scholarship advances our mission to educate, inspire, and develop children into future leaders of the Church and community by expanding financial supports for new school families. An online application process will assist in determining eligibility — supporting families throughout the Greater Rochester, Finger Lakes, and Southern Tier regions.

The Department of Catholic Schools will assist new families with selecting and enrolling in a Diocese of Rochester school location throughout the application process. The Building A Brighter Future Scholarship provides tuition assistance on a year-by-year basis. Each academic year will present the opportunity for new families to apply for the scholarship.

Reddington Scholarship

The Reverend John A. Reddington Scholarship Fund was established under the Will of Father John Reddington to provide for Catholic education at any level and for college education (non-denominational) for residents of the Diocese of Rochester.

A scholarship committee exists to review all applications and to select individuals to receive scholarship grants. There is no limit on the number of times a student may apply for a scholarship. Scholarships are not automatically renewed each year. Students must reapply annually.

The committee will only consider those applications that indicate a family's maximum yearly income of \$60K or less and require proof of pending school registration or completed school registration of student. This Scholarship is open to students going into K thru Grade 5.
