This Month's Focus

Reading- This month we will continue doing some creative writing. We will be working on some poetry pieces and having a lot of fun sharing them in class. Our next piece of writing will be an opinion piece. We hope to have these on display in the hallway to share with all. Also, we will begin reading Love That Dog by Sharon Creech.

Math- We will be continuing to work with Chapter #4 which is teaching the concepts of multiplication and division. We have completed our units working with double digit multiplication and division. However, these operations will continue to be used throughout the school year, be sure to practice the multiplication facts as often as possible.

Social Studies- For the month of January we will be doing some reading and writing about European explorers. We will begin a long term project having to do with Explorers soon. Students will be able to explain why European explorers came to New York and identify the explorers and the areas that they explored.

Science- We will be starting a new unit this week about Waves of Sound: Sound, Waves, and Communication. Also, we will be doing some mini units about the month of January and how the months of the year got their names and a little mini unit about why bears hibernate.
