Student may return to school when:

Proceed to class

following all school

safety protocol

quarantine if symptom-free

School communicates with County Health Department*

^{*}Any directive from Health Organizations supersedes all protocol in place at the school.

Screening Protocol: Must determine if any individual has:

- (a) knowingly been in close or proximate contact in the past 14 days with anyone who has tested positive through a diagnostic test for COVID-19 or who has or had symptoms of COVID-19;
- (b) tested positive through a diagnostic test for COVID-19 in the past 14 days;
- (c) has experienced any symptoms of COVID-19, including a temperature of greater than 100.0°F, in the past 14 days; and/or
- (d) has traveled internationally or from a state with widespread community transmission of COVID-19 per the New York State Travel Advisory in the past 14 days.

Quarantine Protocol: Transition to home learning arrangements for 14 days with continued monitoring for symptoms Requires direct exposure to a positive case

- Cohort/class of an individual who tests positive for COVID-19;
- Immediate family members (siblings) of an individual who tests positive for COVID-19

Attendance Codes:

- Individuals out sick: Excused Absence (EA)
- Individuals in quarantine or asymptomatic (participating in home learning): Distance Learning (DL)
